Patients will spend less time in the clinic while being matched with the most biomechanically suitable foot. Meanwhile, practitioners will no longer have to juggle ordering and returning multiple feet from manufacturers. I also believe this technology will provide strong medical justification when obtaining a new foot for a patient transitioning from their preparatory prosthesis to their definitive one,” said Brad Scott, Director of Prosthetics & Orthotics at ēlizur.

Humotech’s Caplex® System allows patients to trial a range of prosthetic foot options in real time, generating experiential data that supports clinicians in matching individuals with the most appropriate device. This data also helps justify medical necessity to payors, addressing one of the most pressing challenges in the multi-billion-dollar prosthetics and orthotics industry.



Pilot activities in Pittsburgh are just the beginning. Humotech is actively lining up additional pilot sites across the country and world, reinforcing its mission to ensure all individuals have access to the best available technology to achieve their mobility goals.
